

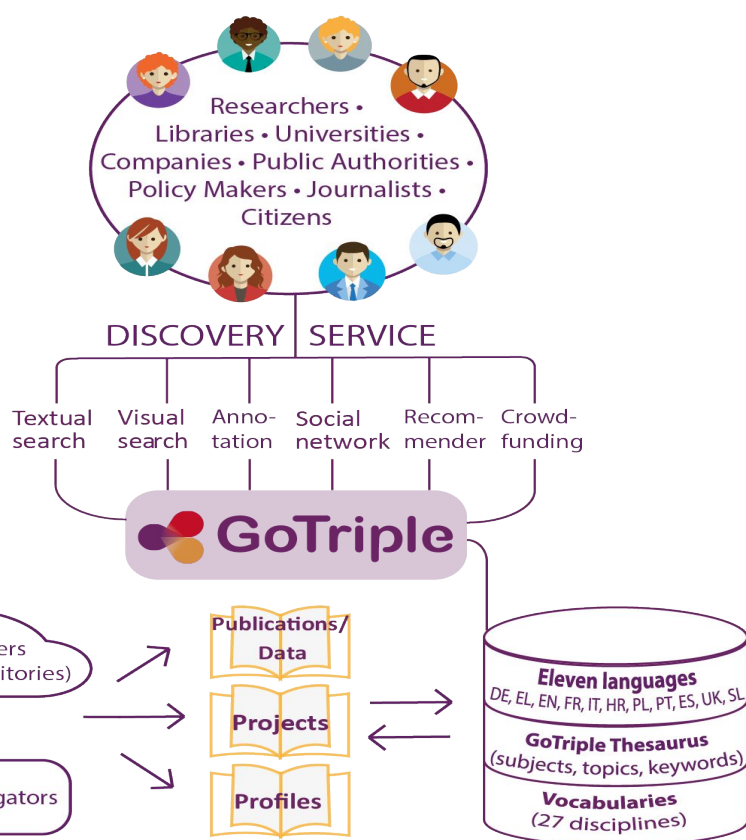
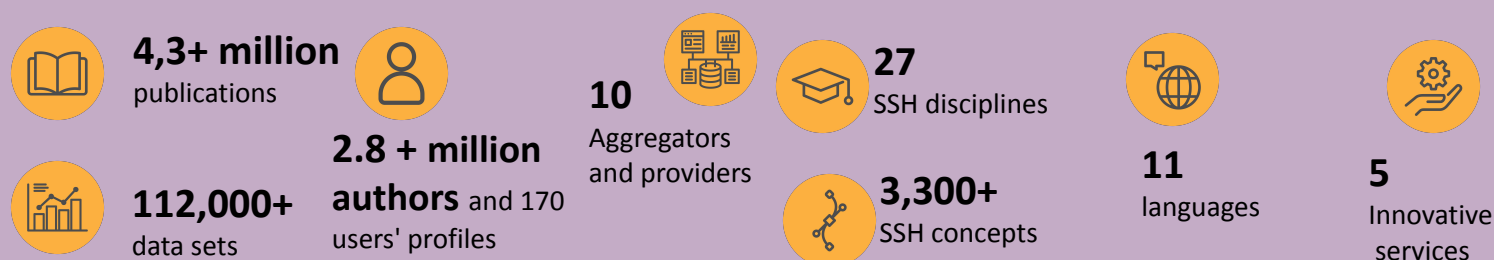

GoTriple is...

an innovative multilingual discovery solution for the social sciences and humanities (SSH). It provides a single access point for discovering research artefacts that are relevant to the wide variety of disciplines under the umbrella domain of SSH: publications and research data, project descriptions and researcher profiles. These are automatically imported from aggregators, semantically enriched and linked in GoTriple. Users will also have access to a number of additional innovative tools and applications.

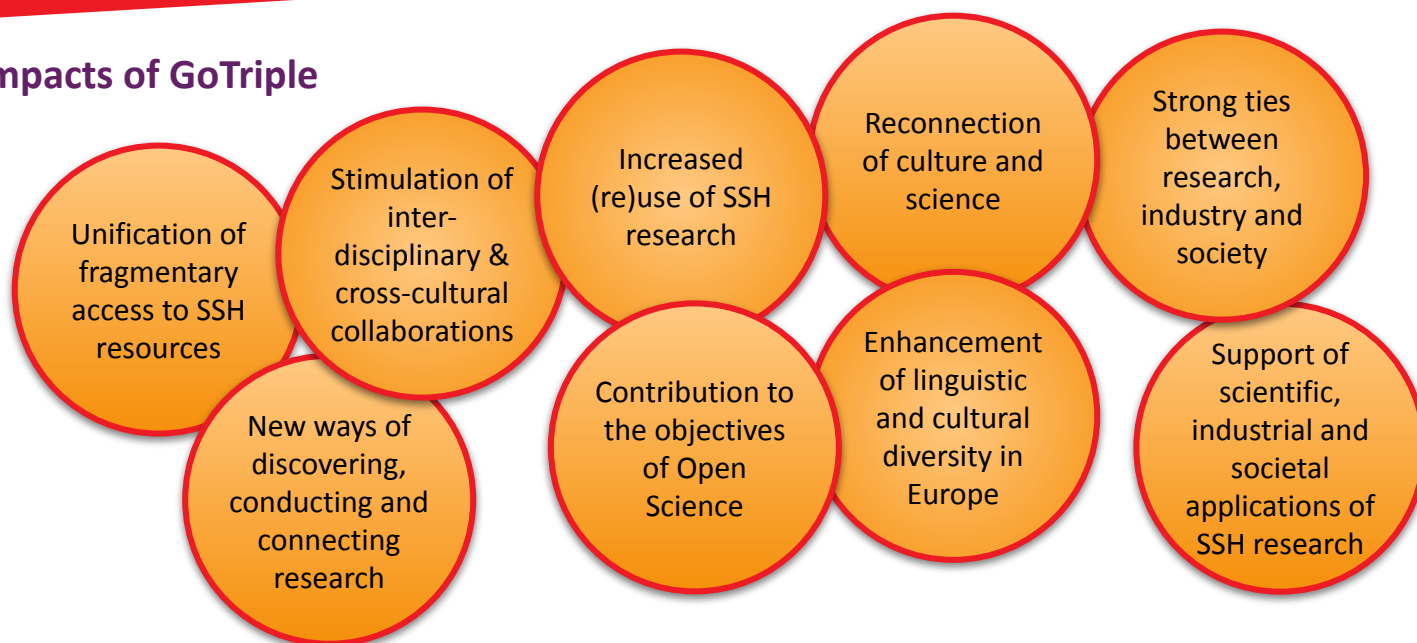

GoTriple is developed as part of TRIPLE, a project financed under the Horizon 2020 Framework Programme “Developing the European research infrastructures for 2020 and beyond” with approx. 5.6 million Euros for a duration of 42 months (2019–2023). TRIPLE, which stands for “Transforming Research through Innovative Practices for Linked Interdisciplinary Exploration”, consists of a consortium of 21 partners from 14 European countries.

GoTriple will be the Discovery Service of OPERAS, the Research Infrastructure supporting open scholarly communication in the social sciences and humanities in the European Research Area, and it is designed to be integrated into and thus to enrich the services of the European Open Science Cloud (EOSC) for the SSH communities.
